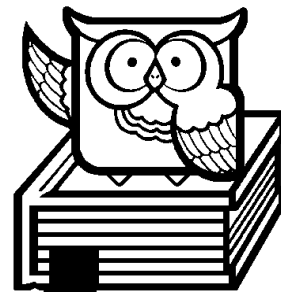

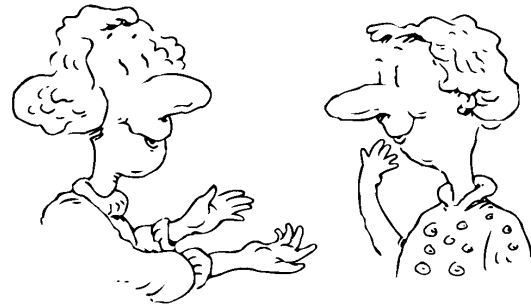

## News from the Librarian's Corner

The library is the proud recipient of the Picturing America award.

"Picturing America, an exciting new initiative from the National Endowment for the Humanities, brings masterpieces of American art into classrooms and libraries nationwide. Through this innovative program, students and citizens will gain a deeper appreciation of our country's history and character through the study

and understanding of its art...."

This initiative provides 40 high-quality reproductions of American Art along with a Teachers Resource Book. The book includes information on all of the images and gives suggestions for using them to enhance library programs and learning in areas such as American history, social studies, writing, literature, art and civics.

Materials will be shipped to the library beginning in March.

The library hopes to partner with the local Junior High to provide innovative programming to junior high students both at the library and in the classroom.

The grant requires that the library have the art on display from April 2009-April 2010. After the grant time is up, we are to continue to make the art available. Since each library is small and doesn't have a lot of room for art, the pictures will be rotated among the main library and branches.
